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Dear Parents/Carers,

Excitingly next week, Mrs Bowerman will be heading outdoors to Brockholes to complete 5 days of Forest Schools Lead Training. This is a part of the curriculum which we hope to be developing across the school over the next few years in order to enhance the learning and mental health opportunities for all of our children. Miss Groome will be supporting in Reception throughout next week.

The children will be having a taster session with Yogis next Wednesday. This is a group that delivers fun activities which include yoga, mindfulness and relaxation to support mental health and well-being. The teachers are very much looking forward to these sessions!

We have recently purchased a subscription to Collins EBooks which should enhance the home reading scheme particularly for our older children. The site gives access via a website or apps to a library of reading books. The books that your child can access will have been selected by the teacher at an appropriate level for your child to read. We will be sending instructions via Parentmail for those of you who may need help to access the library. Your child's username and password will be shared with you on Showbie (for those children who are part of the iPad scheme your children should already be logged in). The number of EBooks for the younger children is limited but as a result of a very generous donation to school we have been able to purchase a substantial amount of 'real' books that link with the children's phonics phases for the children to read at home. We feel it is very important for all of our children to experience both 'real' books and EBooks.

On Thursday 20th October 2.00pm – 3.10pm (the final Thursday of half term) parents are invited into school to come and work with children in their own classrooms on curriculum activities that they have been covering this half term. If you have more than one child, we are happy for you to move between classrooms but ask that children do not move with you and remain in their own classes. We will ask parents to wait outside the classrooms from 3.10pm so that we can ensure everyone gets home or to After School Club safely. Please could you sign up on Parentmail if you will be attending so that we know how many people to expect.
