Year 3/4/5 performed a wonderful dress rehearsal of Cinderella Rockafella to the rest of the school on Thursday afternoon. It was very well received but unfortunately, I was unable to attend due to a pre-booked meeting. I am so looking forward to seeing the whole play myself on Monday with the Year 3 parents at 2.15pm. The performance for Year 4 parents will be on Wednesday at 2.15pm and Year 5 parents on Thursday at 2.15pm.

On Monday we are looking forward to the long-awaited return of Mrs Hall to Year 4 following her accident in September last year. She will be building back up to her full-time hours over the next few weeks and I'm sure you will all give her a warm welcome back.

Next Tuesday our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths) Partner, Dr Rob Smith will be visiting all classes to talk about our Growing Research Project which we have received funding for from The Royal Society. Our overall investigation is 'Can we germinate seeds from harvested produce to produce a cheap and sustainable food source?'. The children have really enjoyed taking the initial steps of harvesting and planting a variety of seeds and are now looking forward to transferring these into our planting beds as the warmer months progress. We hope to produce some information on our findings and some growing/planting guides for the local community, as well as some recipes for using our school grown produce.

Next week is our last week in school before our 2 week Easter break. School will break up at the usual time on Friday 31st March and I am very much looking forward to seeing who has won our Progress and Kindness Cups for this half term.
