Outstanding payments

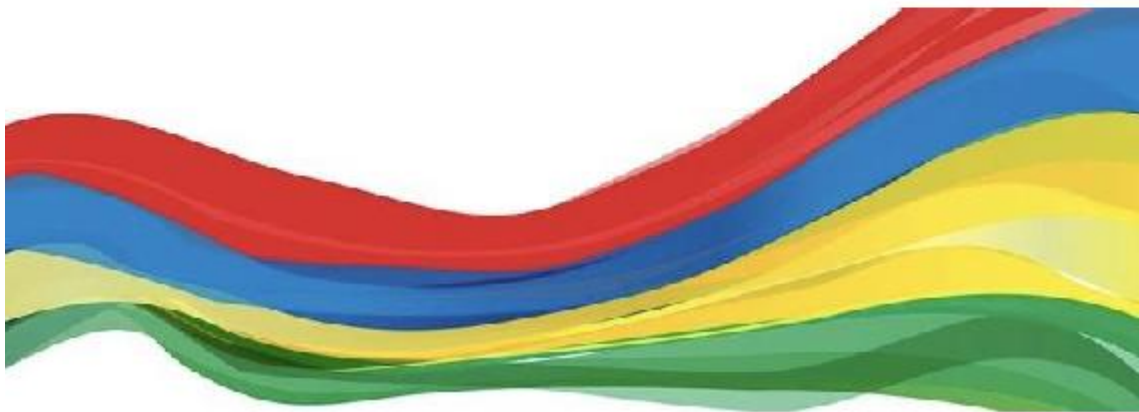
As we are once again approaching the end of another half term it would be appreciated if any outstanding payments for lunches, care club and trips could be paid as a matter of urgency wherever possible.
