Match days will be on a Sunday morning and training currently on a Thursday evening.

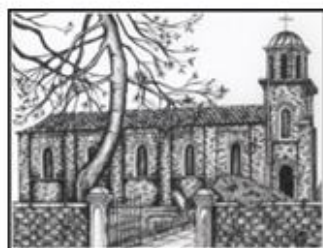
If you have a daughter current in Year 1 that would love to play football then we would love her to join us.
