Dear Parents/Carers,

This week has been an exciting week for the majority of our Year 6 children as they had their full day visit to Carr Hill. Only 3 weeks left for them now at Strike Lane – how time flies! I am looking forward to their final school production next week on Tuesday afternoon at 2pm, if you are a Year 6 parent please make sure you have signed up on Arbor to attend.

On Monday our school governor, Mrs Mitchell, held a badminton tournament for Y5 and Y6 children in Badminton Club. Congratulations to Katie (Y5) who won for the girls and Ellis (Y6) who won for the boys. There must be some good badminton family genes there as Katie and Ellis are siblings! Well done to Georgina (Y6) and Nate (Y6) who claimed second places. The matches were quite close and there were some good long rallies. All the children played really well and have improved such a lot this year.

We are hopeful that there will be good weather for our Sports Day next week on Wednesday. Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be out on the field for 9.30am and Year 3-6 will be there at 1.30pm. We will be following the same programme as in previous years as children move round in classes to a range of activities and compete against each other, gaining points for their colour team. Notification will be sent via the Arbor App on Wednesday morning should Sports Day need to be cancelled due to bad weather.

On Thursday morning we will have the first of our moving up sessions for Reception to Year 5 children. This will give children time to get to know their new teacher, and teaching assistant, for the following school year much better. As many of you know Mrs Kershaw will be taking her class up to Year 1 before she takes maternity leave during the first half term of the new school year. We have appointed Miss Beth Postlethwaite as the maternity cover teacher for Year 1 and she will be meeting the children during these moving up sessions as well as prior to the start of Mrs Kershaw's maternity leave. Miss Postlethwaite is currently working in a Year 1 class in Poulton and is very excited to be joining us.

Don't forget that on Friday it is our Summer Fair, this will start as the children finish school on Friday and will be on the KS2 playground. We will have performances from our Cheerleading, Street Dance and Ju-Jitsu Clubs as well as many stalls, games and activities so please come and join us until 5pm.

Friday is also non-uniform day for all children in exchange for some chocolate for the chocolate tombola stall at the fair. We are hoping for sunshine, but not so much that the chocolate melts!!!

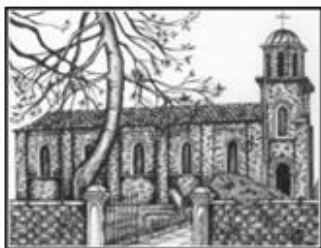
