 NOTE THAT THIS WILL NEED TO BE PAID FOR FROM MONDAY OF THE WEEK OF THEIR 5TH
 BIRTHDAY. You will receive a reminder email for this it will need to be ordered by Tuesday, the
 week before the free milk expires.


