#### Dear Parents/Carers,

What a fabulous end to this Spring Term we have had with 3 performances of Dragon Days by our Year 3/4/5 children and Easter Bingo of course!

Yesterday we said 'Goodbye' to Mrs King who has been our trainee teacher in Year 2 this term. We wish her every success as she moves on to complete her final placement in the Summer Term and then in her future career.

Year 1 had a very exciting visit from Firefighter Richard on Monday. He came to tell them all about his job, keeping people safe, and to show them his uniform. The children were all enthralled and had made him a lovely birthday card for his birthday the following day.

On the week of our return to school we will be finding out who our new Reception children will be for September 2024 and will be starting our arrangements for induction into school. Initially a new parents meeting will be held on Thursday 2nd May at 5.30pm so that we can explain the procedures and answer any questions new parents may have.

We will also be hoping to finalise the dates and itinerary for our London Trip for next year's Year 5 children (current Year 4). We are just waiting for the Houses of Parliament to open up their booking system for Autumn school visits.

Of course, we have Year 6 SATS coming up in the week beginning Monday 13th May and we will be carrying out some practice SATS in the weeks prior to this. It goes without saying that regular attendance is vital to ensure that the children feel fully supported and confident in their abilities to showcase their progress and achieve well. Year 2 SATS are no longer a statutory requirement however, at Strike Lane we will continue to complete these as they give us an accurate assessment of children's achievement and progress from Reception and also help us to measure yearly progress and expectations throughout Key Stage 2. The Year 2 SATS will take place in June, alongside the statutory Year1 Phonics Screening and the Year 4 Multiplication Check.

Finally, a huge thankyou to all of our helpers who worked so hard to tidy and cut back all of our outdoor areas last Sunday. The grounds look so much more appealing and are now ready for us to begin our class growing projects again after Easter.


