Dear Parents & Carers,

We have had a very quiet end to this week with most of our Year 6 in Winmarleigh. The children have returned exhausted, bedraggled and full of great memories, I am sure their parents will hear all about their escapades this weekend. Most of our children from Year 2 upwards have been enrolled onto a new web-based Reading scheme called Reading Plus which is designed to develop the skills of fluent readers. In the next 2 weeks our Y2 – Y6 staff will be sharing login details with you so that the children can continue their reading, vocabulary and skills lessons at home as well as in school, reading a variety of texts appropriate for their assessed reading level. The more they read the quicker they will progress through the scheme. Please don't worry if your child is not registered on this scheme yet, they will be having additional support with their phonics and decoding skills to improve their reading fluency.

Mr Layzell, Headteacher from Carr Hill, will be visiting school next Thursday at 2.30pm to talk with Year 6 parents and children about the opportunities at Carr Hill as you prepare to apply for High School places for next year. Just a reminder that online applications must be completed by 31st October.
